New committee for ISHR Mid-career Investigators – SEND YOUR APPLICATION!

As you all know the ISHR has an outstanding program for Early Career Investigators (ECIs), which ISHR International defines as within 8 years of their terminal degree. A survey that was done just following the 2016 World Congress indicated that networking and other opportunities for Mid-Career Investigators (MCIs) were lacking and that this was an area in which ISHR could improve for the 2019 World Congress. For this reason ISHR would like to establish an MCI committee similar to the committee in place for the ECIs. We appreciate that the interest and activities of the MCI will be different than ECIs. We would like to assemble a group of MCIs (to meet initially by skype) and let them tell us what they need. MCIs would be defined as between 8 and 15 years post terminal degree (excluding anyone who has reached the rank of full professor).
